Dániel Gryllus and Vilmos Gryllus are members of the broadly popular Hungarian Kaláka Ensemble. Kaláka plays own adaptations of Hungarian folk music, street music, children's songs and poems set to tone. Formed in 1969, Kaláka gained recognition both in and outside Hungary and soon became one of the most prominent actor on the Hungarian cultural scene. In 2000 Kaláka was awarded the highest Hungarian artistic award – the Kossuth prize.

Their album
„Once there was a little Jew”
features Jiddish folk songs from Transsylvania, translated to Hungarian by poet Sándor Kányádi. The album was originally produced in 1994 and has recently received new impetus with including the world-class Hungarian singer, Ági Szalóki among the performing artists.
